Dear Prime Minister Harper:

Subject: That Canada adopt the “UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous People”

I am writing to encourage your government to boldly reflect the spirit of our recent apology to our First Nations sisters and brothers by formally adopting the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous People.

At the recently concluded 12<sup>th</sup> Biennial Convention of the Eastern Synod Assembly of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada, the following motion was passed by the assembly:

that this synod express its support for the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples adopted by the General Assembly on September 13, 2007, and express its disappointment that the Canadian Government has chosen not to commit Canada to fulfilling our responsibilities under this universal human rights standard – the first time that Canada has sought to be exempted from a human rights standard adopted by the General Assembly. The synod encourages the Government of Canada and the Governments of all the Provinces to join with the overwhelming majority of states, jurisdictions, Indigenous peoples and human rights organizations worldwide that endorse this standard.

We believe that the people of Canada ought to join the many other jurisdictions who have found this Declaration to be a helpful “remedial instrument.” As Canadians fulfill our obligations under this Declaration we will be helped to overcome the marginalization and discrimination that so many indigenous people in Canada have faced due to “historical processes of colonization, conquest and dispossession.”

I encourage the Government of Canada, together with our Provincial and Territorial Governments, to send a clear message to both the international community and our own citizens that we, in Canada, will uphold all the rights of our Indigenous peoples.
